



The above is a Draught of a survey made the 11<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1786, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Morris Canady on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Oct<sup>r</sup> 1784, Situate on the waters of the Brush fork of Ten Mile Creek, joining William Guyer, in Washington County, called the Stone Quarry, containing four hundred Acres with the usual roads.
