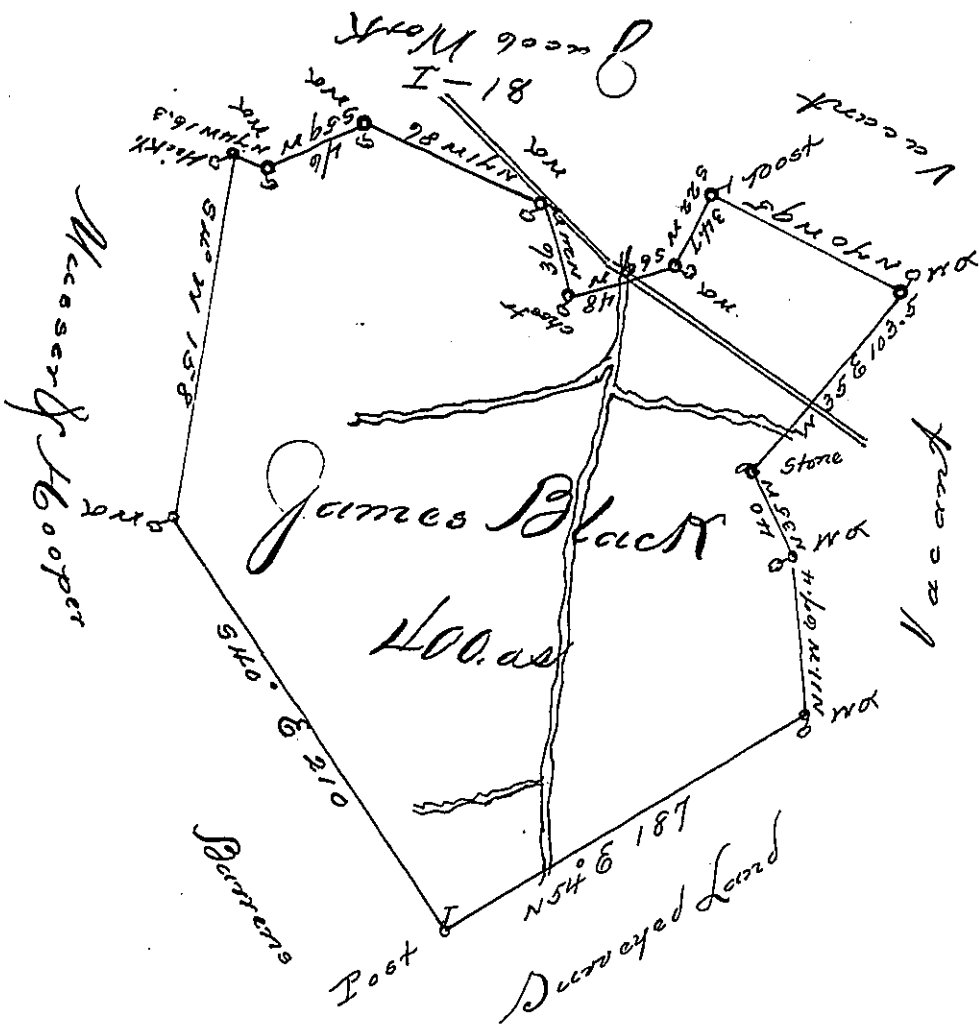


Note - The warrant name is James Black Junr.



Situate on both sides of the Pennsylvania Great Road east of  
 Quenahoning Township Bedford County and surveyed the 1st.  
 day of March 1787. Returned into the Surveyor General's  
 Office in consequence of a warrant for 400 ac. of Land on the  
 mouth of the Beaver Dam Run, including a large Cherry bottom.  
 Dated the 5th day of Augt. 1785. which warrant could not be  
 filled where located by Reason of a prior warrant in the name  
 of Robert Parish Dated the 12th March 1785.
