



The above is a Draught of a Survey made 1st Day February 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Ann Smith, dated the 25th day of October 1784, Situated on a branch of the South fork of ten mile in Washington County. Called Bear Camp, containing four hundred acres with the usual allowance of 6 ft. Ct. for Roads &c.
