



In Pursuance of an Appⁿ No 1796 for Three hundred acres of land Granted to John Masden, a Survey was made thereon by James Hendrick of Two hundred & Fifty seven acres & three quarters & allow^{ce} which not filling up - ob^t - Appⁿ an addition was made there ob^t by Alex^r McClean Esq^r Dep^y Surr^y of Westmoreland Co^y in Jan^y 1706 of Eighty four acres & allowance making in the whole Three hundred & Forty one acres & three quarters & ob^t as above represented being Situate on Charliers Creek on the West side of Monongahala River formerly Westmoreland County now in the County of Washington - laid down, protracted & Calculated from the field works of Hendricks & McClean's Deputy Surveyors
