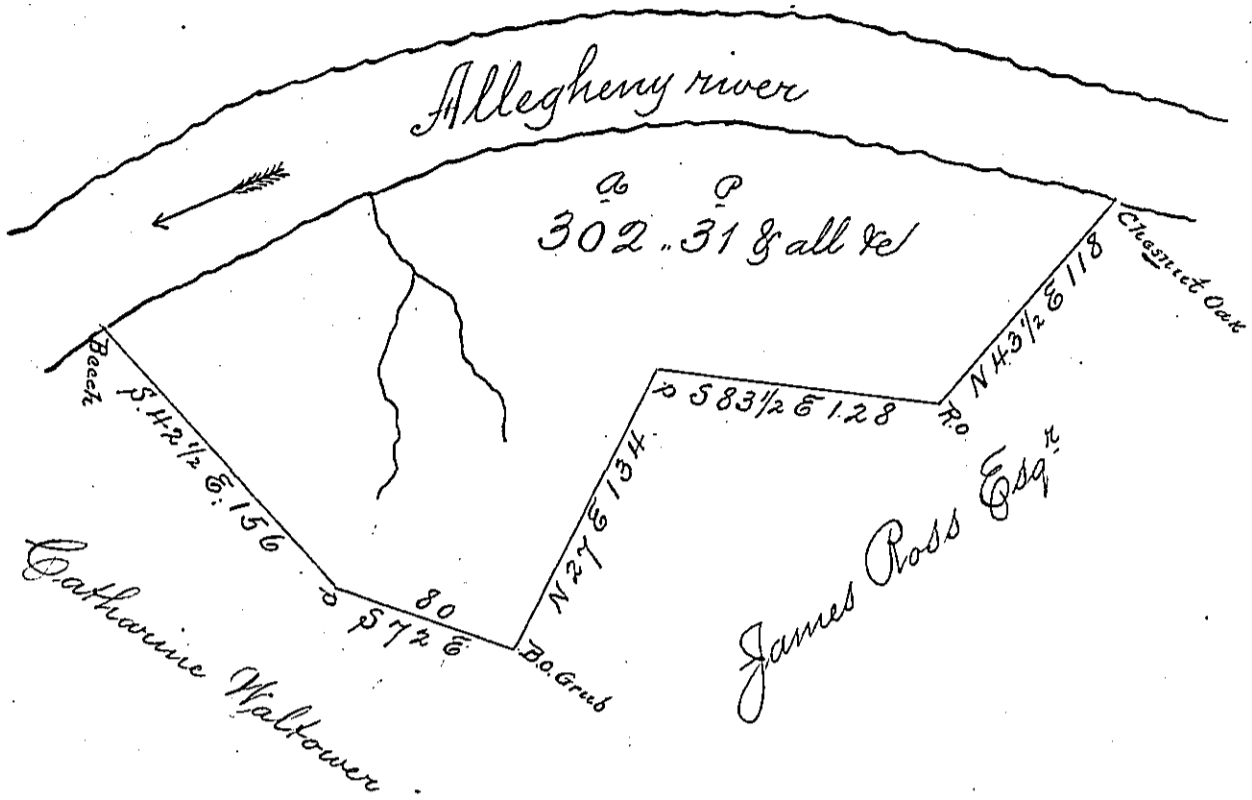

Draft of a tract of land situate in Pitt township Allegheny county on the Allegheny river, containing three hundred & two acres thirty one perches & allowance of six per cent Surveyed for John Fritchman the 1st day of November 1808, - being part of the tract of land that was surveyed George Cochran by Robert M. Grea D. S. on the 26th & 27th June 1769 by virtue of Order N^o 20. dated 1st June * 1769 - and being part of the tract which on the general return of the same survey is stated to contain 586 acres, 26 perches & allowance.
