



A Draught of a Survey situate on the Ohio River in Washington County at a place called Flaugherty's Bottom, containing 1000^{ac.} as strictly measured, executed Decem^r. 7th 1787, in consequence of a Pre-emption warrant for 1000 ac. granted to Dorsey Perdecost, by the State of Virginia and assigned to Mess^{rs}. Darn^o. & Rob^t. Purviance which warrant was entered with the County Sur^v. May 4th 5th 1780, as appears from the list of Entries on warrants transmitted from the Sur. Gen^l. Office

Note, least a Patent might not issue for 1000 ac. as is the custom in Virg^a we divided it into smaller tracts
