



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Maxatawny Township now in the County of Berks, but formerly in the County of Philadelphia in the Province of Pennsylvania, Being the equal half part of a Tract of 300 acres, Tract in pursuance of a warrant from the Honorable the Proprietaries dated the 23^d August Anno. 1735, was surveyed unto George Bost (or Gerrick Post) who sold his right to the other half part unto Jacob Miller, in whom the right to the same was vested December 3. 1744, and the above Tract containing one hundred and 67. acres and Three quarters of an acre of Land together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads. He the said George Bost sold to his son John Bost, formerly surveyed and divided by Edward Scull Surveyor. Re surveyed on the 5th Day of May Anno. 1763.
