



The above Draught represents a Tract of Land situate in Sadsbury Township Containing 38<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> p. & the allowance of six p Cent for Roads &c. being part of a tract of 148<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and allowance formerly surveyed to William Armstrong upon his warrant dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of June AD, 1750, and which has been divided and laid off to Gilbert Gibb & Susannah his wife in right of the said Susannah as Daughter of the said William Armstrong, who is deceased.
