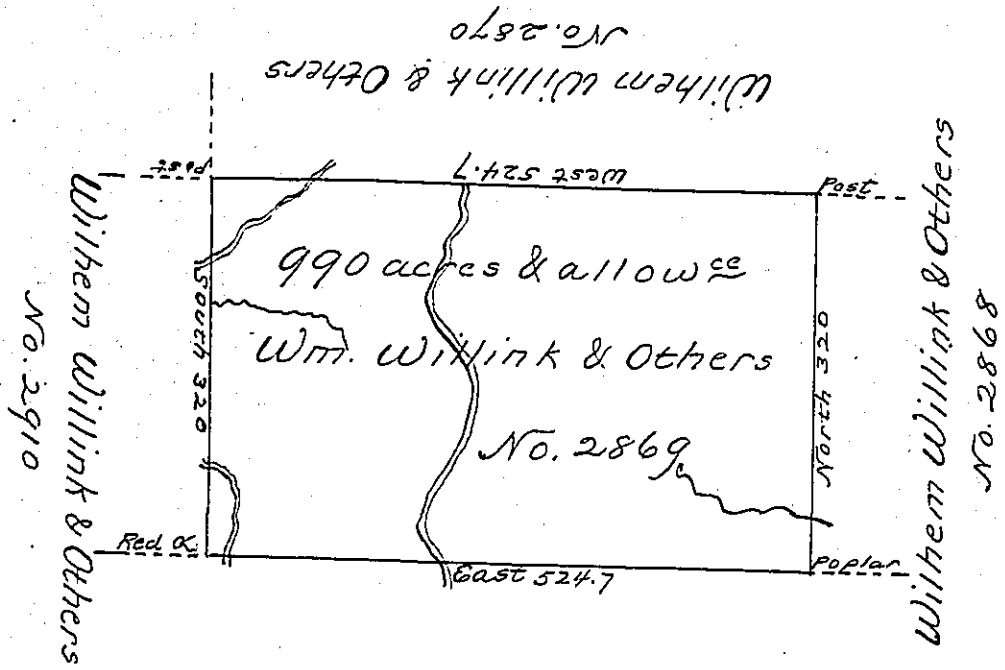

Day of December 1792
