

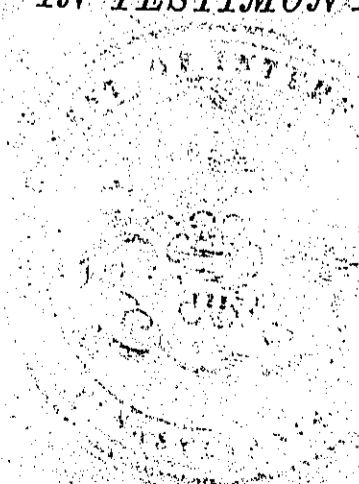

The above tract was surveyed to Peter Shelleber^{gar} sometime in the year 1798 in Pursuance of a warrant dated the 6th of May 1738 But the Surveyor dying and no return of the survey ~~be~~ he had made to be found Wm Galbreath was ordered to examine the lines and return them Pursuant to Peter Shelleberger warrant of y^e 6th of May.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of February 1907.
