

By Order of the Proprietaries surveyed to Joseph Sherock a Tract of Land in the Township of Hempfield Beginning at a Black Oak in the Line of Christian Carver thence North 73 Deg East 244 perches to a Sicory thence South 35 Deg East 36 p to a white oak thence North 81 Deg East 153 perches to a white oak thence North west by North 54 1/2 perches to a white oak thence South 81 Deg West 154 perches to a post thence North 55 Deg West 138 p to a Sicory thence North 85 Deg 1/2 West 149 perches to a white oak thence South 1 Deg 1/2 East 212 perches to the place of Beginning Containing Two Hundred forty four Acres of Land with the usual allowance of six Acres per Cent for Roads be surveyed May the 23rd Anno Domini 1735
