The ~~whole~~ whole of the above survey is included within bounds of a survey made for William Derry Esq. in pursuance of an Order dated May 23<sup>rd</sup> 1769. No 3268, in the name of John Wilson, and a warrant dated May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1773 in the name of John Derry. Hearhold is in possession of the Land.
