



A Draft of a Tract of land called the Garden situated on the Heads of the heads of the West branch of Susquehanna about a Mile S.E. W. from Mark's sleeping Place adjoining lands of Catherine Ann Reading in Frankstown Township now in Huntingdon Bedford County containing 312 as & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads to be surveyed in pursuance of an Order No: 5280 dated the 23^d Day of May 1769.

Note a survey had been made on the 28th day of September 1773 by Thomas Smith Esquire when Deputy Surveyor of Bedford County whose field Notes I have examined and find to be accurate
