



Situate in Franklin (formerly Hanaghan) Township, York County, containing as above set forth fifty four acres, one hundred and twenty one perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & ca. Being part of a larger tract of 185^{ac} & allowance originally surveyed by Charles Finkens late D.S. for George Steele in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Peter Gallaher dated the 16th day of October 1750. The said part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 15th day of February AD 1822, for Frederick Stoker at whose request the same is returned for confirmation
