



Situate on the waters of Grassy Run in Springhill Township, Fayette County and surveyed the 18th day of December 1834 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Philip Davis & Samuel Davis for 60 acres of land dated the eighth day of March 1786. There is about 40 acres in a state of cultivation, a log house, barn, spring house, small orchard on this tract and the family of George Hertzog have been residing thereon from the spring of 1786 to the present time.
