



Draft of a Tract of Land called Patton's Grove situate on the Easterly Branch of Nanticoke Creek on the South side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna in the County of Luzerne about one Mile from the same containing Two hundred and Twenty five acres Eighty six Perches and the usual allowance of six per Centum for Roads Surveyed for Richard Patton the 5th Day of July 1769 by Charles Stewart Esq deceased then Deputy Surveyor in Pursuance of an Order of Survey bearing date the 3^d Day of April 1769 certified this 27th Day of May 1801.
