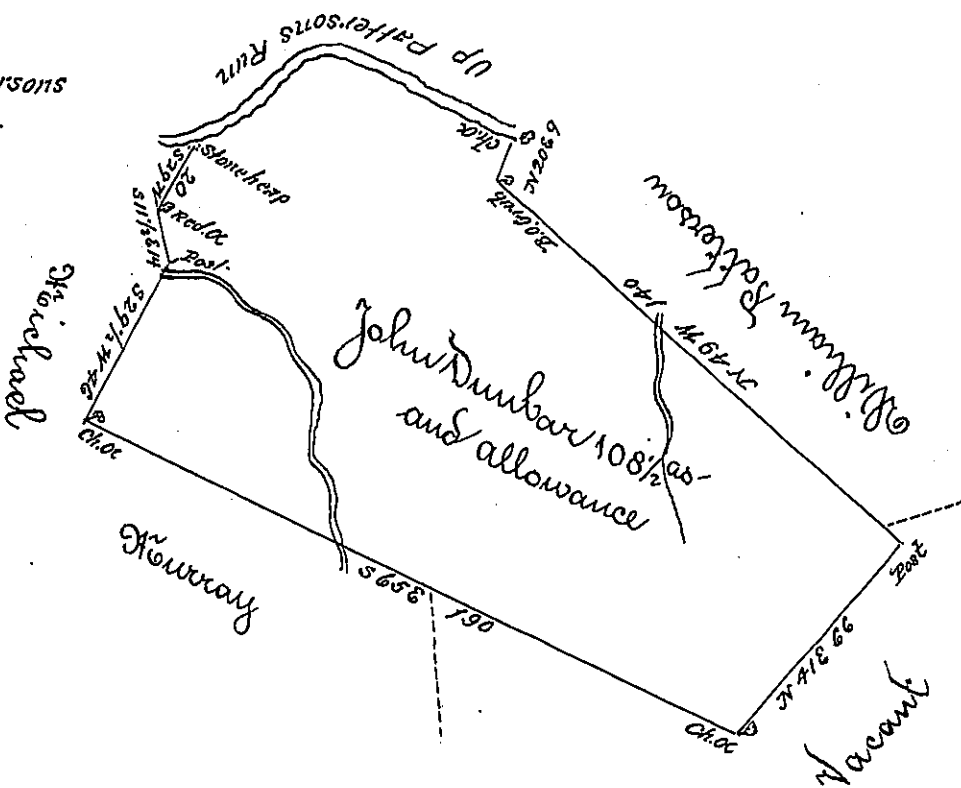


Courses and Distances up Pattersons
