



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 27th of May Anno Domini 1738 The above Described Tract of Land Surveyed unto David Alexander on a mountain Between Pequet and Conecogue in Lancaster County Beginning At a Stone Thence West 54 poles to a chestnut Oak, Thence South 200 poles to a Black Oak Thence North 75 Degrees East 120 poles to a chestnut Oak Thence North 20 Degrees West Bounding on every side on Vacant Land, Containing Ninety five Acres Beside ye allowance of six per cent
