



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor. Dated 3rd day of June Anno Domini 1734. The above described ^{two} Tracts of Land was Surveyed to Conrad Civer and Adam Doder in Right of Peter Bellar. In Erie Township Lancaster County. For said Civer begins at a post on of Jacob Bowman's Conestogoe Creek thence down the same on the several courses thereof 70 perches to a post, Corner of Adam Doder thence South 10 Degrees West 40 perches to a post, thence South South East both by said Doder 182 perches to a post in the line of Christian Winger. thence East by North ^{by} Do. 47 perches to a post. thence North by West by said Winger and Jacob Bowman 220 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Eighty acres and allowance of six ^{perches} Rods for Roads.

For Adam Doder. Begins at a post Cor. of Conrad Civer by Conestogoe Creek thence down the same on the several courses thereof 188 perches to a post in the line of Abraham Heitsbaum thence South South East 29 perches to a White Oak, thence East 74 perches to a Hickory thence South by East. Both by Daniel Herman 154 perches to a post, thence East by North by Christian Winger 47 perches to a post, Cor. of Conrad Civer thence North North West by Do. 182 perches to a post.
