



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of Jan^y, 1759, I have surveyed the 2^d day of the same month unto John Doyle the above described lot of Ground situate on the Bank of Delaware in the City of Philadelphia & between Mulberry Street & Cassafra's Street. Containing in Breadth North & South, fifty seven feet one Inch & in depth Nineteen feet seven Inches, Bounded Eastwrd with Water Street, Southward with Ground now in y^e Tenure of Robert Wain, Westward with Ground of Ruth Webb & Mary Taggart & Northward with Ground of John Parrock, deceased,
 Nick^o. Scull.
