



By order of the Proprietary Surveyd the 20th. day of May 1735 to Joseph Coghannour a Tract of Land in Hempfield Township in ye County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak adjoining to Henry Heistants Land thence South West 304 p to a post thence South 121 p to a Black Oak thence East 184 p to a Spanish Oak thence North North East 130 p to a Maple thence North East by East 94 p to a Hicory thence North North East 120 p. to a Black Oak thence North 70 deg^{usual} west 152 p. to the place of Beginning Containing 403 acres & allowance for roads &c.
