



By Virtue of the Proprietary Warrant dated the Second Day of March Anno Dom: 1737 Surveyed to James Campbell on the nineteenth Day of April Anno Dom: 1738, a tract of Land in Derry Township Lancaster County Beginning at a Maple by Spring Creek thence up the same two hundred twenty six perches to a post thence by a tract of Land laid out for the use of the Presbyterian Congregation North Eight Degs East 191 p. to Black oak thence by Vacant Land North 40 Degs west 112 p. to Black oak thence South 15 degs west 190 ps. to a post thence by Land Surveyed to David Campbell South Ten Degs East 190 p. to the Beginning containing Two Hundred seventy nine acres & the usual allowance for Roads &c.
