



Surveyed on the ^{18th} ~~sixth~~ day of February 1734 to Benjamin Boone a Tract of Land Situate in Oley in y^e County of Philad^a Beginning at a hickory tree Markt for a corner thence by land of Ellis Hugh South Seventy two Degrees East one hundred and Ninety to a W^t Oak thence by land of George Boone Jun^r South West forty four perches to a post a corner of S^r Boone's land thence by y^e same South East forty perches to a post a corner of Squire Boone's land thence by y^e same South twenty Degrees West two hundred & two perches to a post thence by Vacant land North seventy Degrees West two hundred & eight perches to a post thence by Vacant land North Twenty Degrees ^{East} two hundred & fifty perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing three hundred acres with usual allowance
