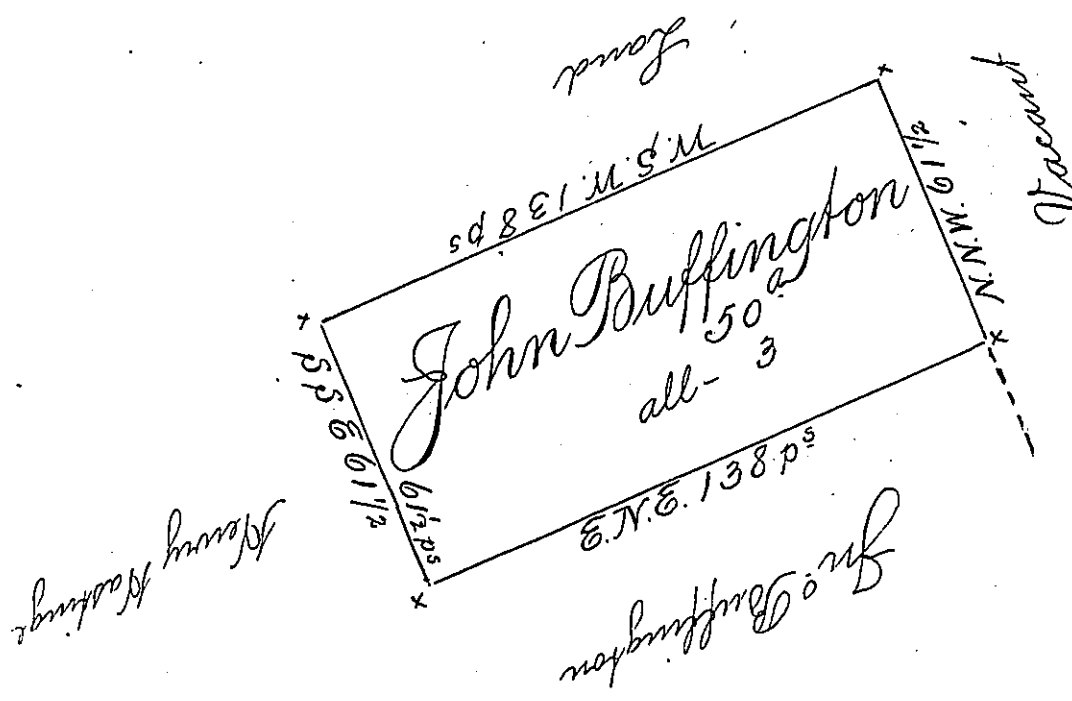

East by the s^r John Buffington's Land 138 p^{es} to the place of Beginning Containing fifty acres and the usual allowance for Roads
