



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated Jan^y of 26. 1733 Surveyed to William Britain a Certain tract of Land in Plumsted Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post a corner of William Allens land thence by land of Samuel Barker South East one hundred and fifty three perches to a Black Oak being a corner of said Barkers land thence by land of Henry Paul North East seventy two perches to a corner stone thence by the same South East one hundred and sixteen perches to a corner stone thence by Lands of Joseph Brown North East fifty four perches to a corner stone thence by the same North West two hundred and sixty nine perches to a Large White Oak thence South West by land of said William Allen one hundred and twenty six perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres ^{1/2} with usual allowance of six p. cont.
