



By Virtue of a Warrant from the ^{Commissioners} Proprietaries Dated the 25th day of May 1719 Surveyed unto Peter Balley a tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad.^a Beginning at a W^t Oak in the line of David Coffmans land thence by Vacant Land North West one hundred and sixty two perches to a post thence by a tract of Land formerly belonging to Thomas Edwards North East two hundred and ten perches to a post thence South East by Land of Nicholas Leshen thirty eight perches & y^e same Course by land of Anthony Lee one hundred & twenty four perches to a corner post about eight foot West from a Mark^t Black Oak thence South West by Land of St Anthony Lee one hundred perches & the same Course by land of David Coffman one hundred & ten perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing two hundred Acres with the usual allowance of Six p^{er} cent
