



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the first day of March 1733 Surveyed unto John Britain a tract of Land Situate on the deep run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a stone in a line of Ebenezer Large's land thence by of same North West one hundred and nine perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East Two hundred and Thirty four perches to a Large Hickery thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and nine perches to a Stone a Corner of Newry Nudelston's land thence by the same South West one hundred and forty one perches and the same Course by land late late of William Wilkinson Nine ^{ty} three perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres with usual allowance of Six p.C Surveyed Octo^r. 1. 1734.
