



From papers remaining in the D.S. office of Lycoming County it appears that the above described track of Land was surveyed (by John Brodhead the then D.S. for that district) on the 10th day of Sept^r 1793 to Peter Pence by virtue of his Warrant No. 790 dated the 15th June 1786. (and at the request of the over resurveyed and returned this 2^d Nov^r 1816.) - Containing One hundred and eighty three Acres with the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Situate on Lyner run in the Last purchase Dunstable Township Lycoming County & bounded as above described.
