



Whereas there was a Warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1744, granted unto John Rice for 100<sup>ac</sup> of Land situate on Trucker's Cr. in the County of Bucks, & Where<sup>s</sup> the same became void & a Warrant grant<sup>d</sup> for the same Land unto Michael Tothorah dat<sup>d</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1747 & Where<sup>s</sup> there was granted to the s<sup>d</sup> Mich<sup>l</sup> Tothorah another Warrant of the same Date for the taking up of 100<sup>ac</sup> contiguous to the above, in Pursuance of which Warrant I have the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1749 Surveyd the above described Tract of Land, Cont<sup>g</sup> Two hundred & thirty five Acres & one Quarter with Allowance of six p<sup>ts</sup>.
