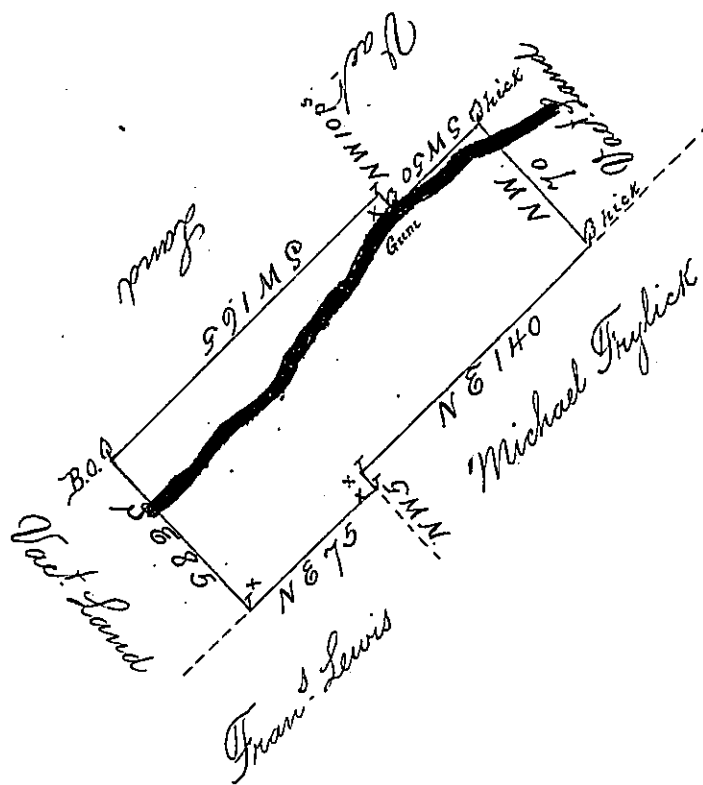

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twenty ninth day of January 17<sup>33</sup> Surveyed unto Adam Scheffer a Tract of Land situate on Three Mile Run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post in a line of Francis Lewis's Land thence by the same North East seventy five perches to a post in a line of Michael Frylick's land thence by the same North West five perches to a post thence by said Frylick's Land North East one hundred and forty perches to a Hickory thence by Vacant land North West seventy perches to a hickory thence by Vacant Land South West fifty perches to a Gum tree thence by Vacant land North West Ten perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred and sixty five perches to a Black <sup>oak</sup> thence by Vacant Land South East Eighty five perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred <sup>or 108 perches</sup> acres with the usual allowance of Six p Cent
