Surveyed to Peter Babb on the 14th day of November then next Ensuing The above Described Tract of Land Situate in West Calm Township in the County of Chester Containing five hundred and forty two Acres and the usual allowance for Roads

May 26th 1741. The Proprietor orders that the lines of this Land be tried again
The pties have again Feb: 10: 1742

Cave. That this be not Returned till James Love who had a Warr^t for 100^{ac} dated y^e 30th of May 1734. & since made a settlement within this be heard.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Seventh day of January 1802.
