



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 3d. January 1740 Resurvey'd according to the Old lines originally run for Peter Barrier, the above described Tract of Land situate in Long Swamp Township formerly in the County of Philadelphia, now in the County of Berks, containing One hundred acres & allowance of 6 p cent.

Resurvey'd the 21st. March 1766
