



The above is a draught of a tract of land in Morris township in Washington Co. containing six acres with the usual allowance - Surveyed in the month of May 1815, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Israel Dilly, dated April 10th. 1815 for nine acres.

There is no improvement whatever on this tract, except about a quarter of an acre which is represented by the dotted line in the south corner, being part of a field owned by said Dilly - There is no claim whatever other than that of Mr. Dilly.
