



Returned February 21st. 1786.

The above is a Draught of Survey made August 7th. 1785. On Certificate granted by the Commissioners (appointed by the State of Virginia) containing 374 acres & 13 perches - called Hatfields Tolly - and is situate in Washington County. A True Copy - March 2<sup>d</sup> 1780 - John Hatfield produced a certificate from the Commissioners of Yohogania Monongalia & Ohio: for 400 acres of land: on the Drains of the Monongahela River: - To Include his settlement made 1770, also a right in preemption of 1000 acres dated 17th of February 1780 and entered the same with me likewise. Entd. 2<sup>d</sup> March 1780. Jno Maddison
