 tract of land situate near ye head of Sacocon Creek adjoining

 Warner land thence by Vacant land South one hundred and
 Eighty perches to a post thence by Vacant land west one hun-
 dred and forty two perches to a Black Oak Sapling thence by
 Vacant land North one hundred and eighty perches to a alder
 sapling thence by Vacant land east twenty perches to ye sd. Warner
 corner being an arch thence by ye sd. Warner ye same course one
 hundred and Twenty two perches to ye place of Beginning contain-
 ing one hundred & fifty acres with ye usual allowance of
