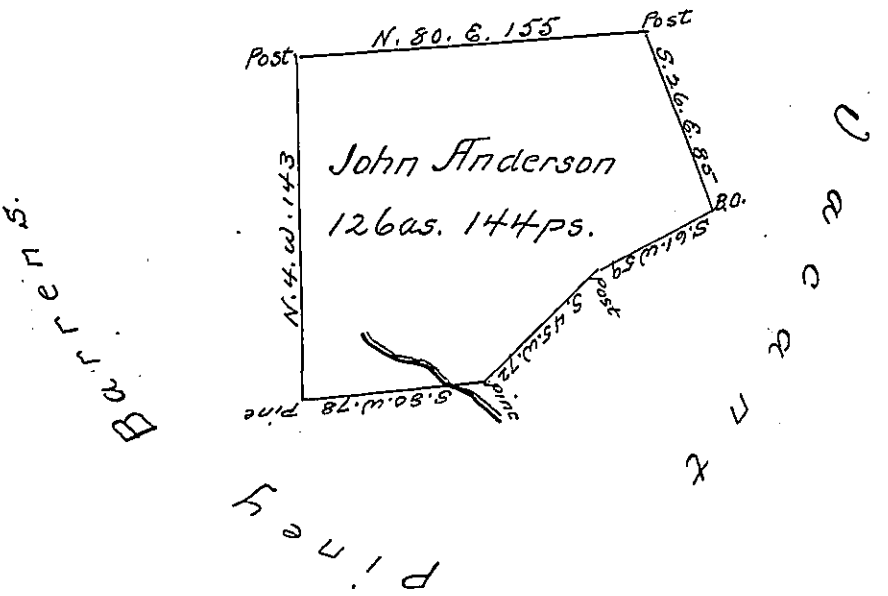


Vacant Land
