



A Draught of a tract of Land Called Iron Mine situate in Nit-tany Vally between the Head waters of Spring Creek & Fishing creek <sup>N.W.</sup> about two Miles of Logans Gap in Bould Eagle Township, Northumberland Count. Surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of June, 1775 for John Lukens, Esq<sup>r</sup>; Containing Thirty four acres & Fifty Six Perches besides the Usual allowance of Six As. Per Cent. for Roads & etc. in Pursuance of a warrant Granted to Tho<sup>s</sup> Gordon. Dated the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of Jan<sup>y</sup>, 1763, it being of the Orig<sup>l</sup> Purchase of Joshua Holland & Joshua Peekover
