Begin at A post thence south seventy Degrees west by Vacant Land one hundred and sixty two perches to A post half A perch Distant from a marked white oak tree thence North twenty Degrees west by vacant Land one hundred and Eighteen perches to a Hickery tree thence north Seventy Degrees East by vacant Land one hundred and ^{one} seventeen perches to a Chesnut tree thence South forty _{Seven} Degrees East by vacant Land one hundred and twenty ^{103 per.} perches to the place of Beginning Containing ninty seven acres and Allowance Surveyd the fourth Day of January Ano. Dom. one thousand seven Hundred and thirty Eight nine.
