



A Draught of a tract of Land situate in Towamensing Township in the County of Northampton on the North side of the blue Mountains in the Province of Pennsylvania, Containing One hundred and Thirty Two Acres and 46 perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six percent for Roads. Surveyed unto John Stroul, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble}. the Proprietaries of this Province Dated the 9th. Day of April, Anno, 1763 That was granted to him by Virtue of another Warrant to Nicholas (obl^{tn}) dated October, 28th. Anno. 1746.
