



A Draught of a tract of Land Called _____ Situate on the waters of Tunkhannock Creek adjoining land granted to William Norton and others in the county of Northumberland containing three hundred and twenty two Acres besides the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. for Roads &c^a. Surveyed the 12th day of August, 1776 for George Clymer. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 19th day of August, 1774.
