The above is a draught of a survey made May 3^d, 1815, in pur-
suance of a Warrant granted to Hiram Parker, dated April 19th, 1815
Containing eighty three acres and seventy seven perches with the
usual allowance. This land is contended for by one England, but
I am of opinion that Englands claim is not well founded - Parker
Commenced his improvement in January, 1815 and has kept it up
ever since. There was no other improvement at that ^{time} whatever,
and England approved of it.
