



A Draught of a tract of land called — situate on the waters of Wyalosing Creek adjoining lands granted to William Gough and others in the County of Northumberland and containing three hundred and One Acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of Six & Cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the fifteenth day of September, 1776 for Lyde Goodwin. In pursuance of a warrant dated 19-Augst, 1774. To John Lukens, Esq<sup>r</sup>, Survey<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. by Chas. Stewart, Dep. Sur<sup>r</sup>.
