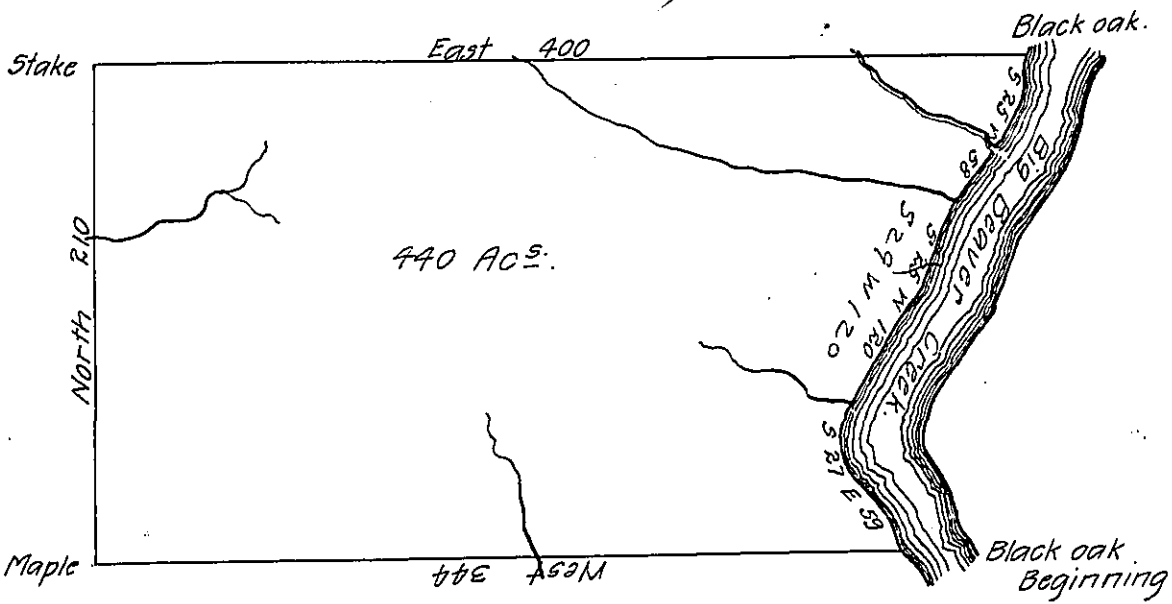

The above is a Draught of a tract of land surveyed the 4th day of April, 1794. In pursuance of a warrant granted to William Barker for 400 Acres of Land dated the third day of April, 1792. Situate north west of the River Ohio on the west Bank of Big Beaver Creek, between the big & Little Falls, adjoining Land granted to Joseph Williams in District No. 10 in Alleghany County Called Black oak Flat. Containing four hundred & Forty acres together with the usual allowance of six p^{ct} Cent. for Roads
