



A Draught of a tract of land surveyed the 30th. day of October, 1800 for James Downing in pursuance of his warrant for 400 acres of Land, Said warrant is not dated, + but is signed by Thomas Mifflin Governor, and it appears in the body of said warrant, that Interest is to commence from the first day of March, 1787, Situate on the waters of Cross Creek in Washington County Called Poland Containing three hundred sixty eight Acres & sixty five perches together with the usual allowance of six per Cent. for Roads.
