This tract was surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1795 on a Warrant in the name of sd M. Kiscock for 400<sup>acs</sup> dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794 and entered in Survey Book E. 140. as 426<sup>acs</sup> By

Alex<sup>r</sup> Mclean D.Y.

But that survey being erroneous it has been Resurveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1831.
