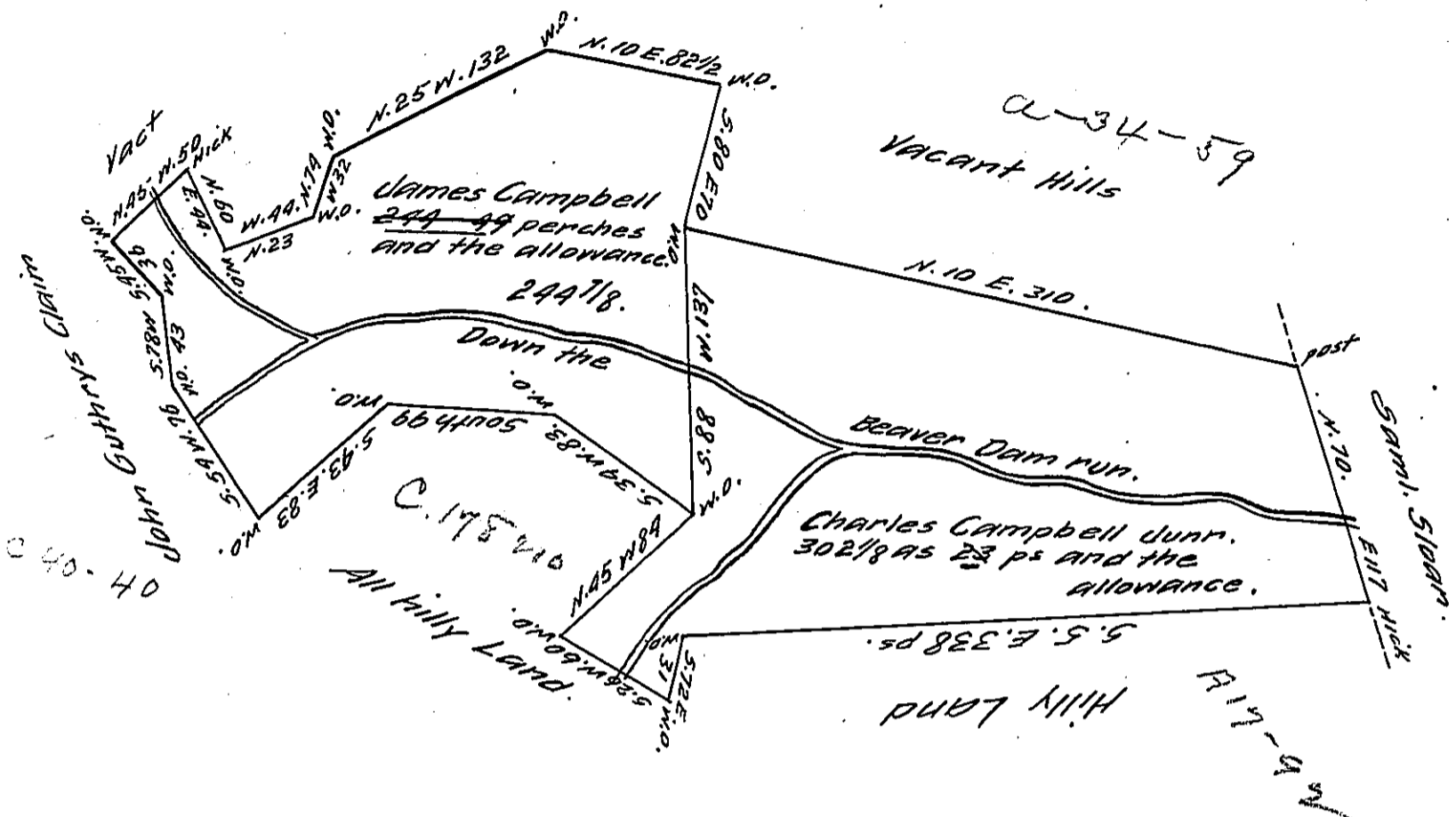


C. 7<sup>th</sup>. 29<sup>th</sup> W<sup>th</sup>

The above is a Draught of two tracts of Land situate on both sides of Beaver run adjoining & below John Gutherys Claim now in Westmorland County. the one survey'd to James Campbell of Cumberland County (called the Miller) contains two Hundred & forty four Acres & 149 perches with an allowance of 6 pcent &c. the other survey'd to Charles Campbell Junr. of Cumberland County. Containing three Hundred & two Acres and 23 perches with the usual allowance as aforesaid Both survey'd the 6th of May 1773 In pursuance of two Warrants each Dated the 27th of february 1773.
