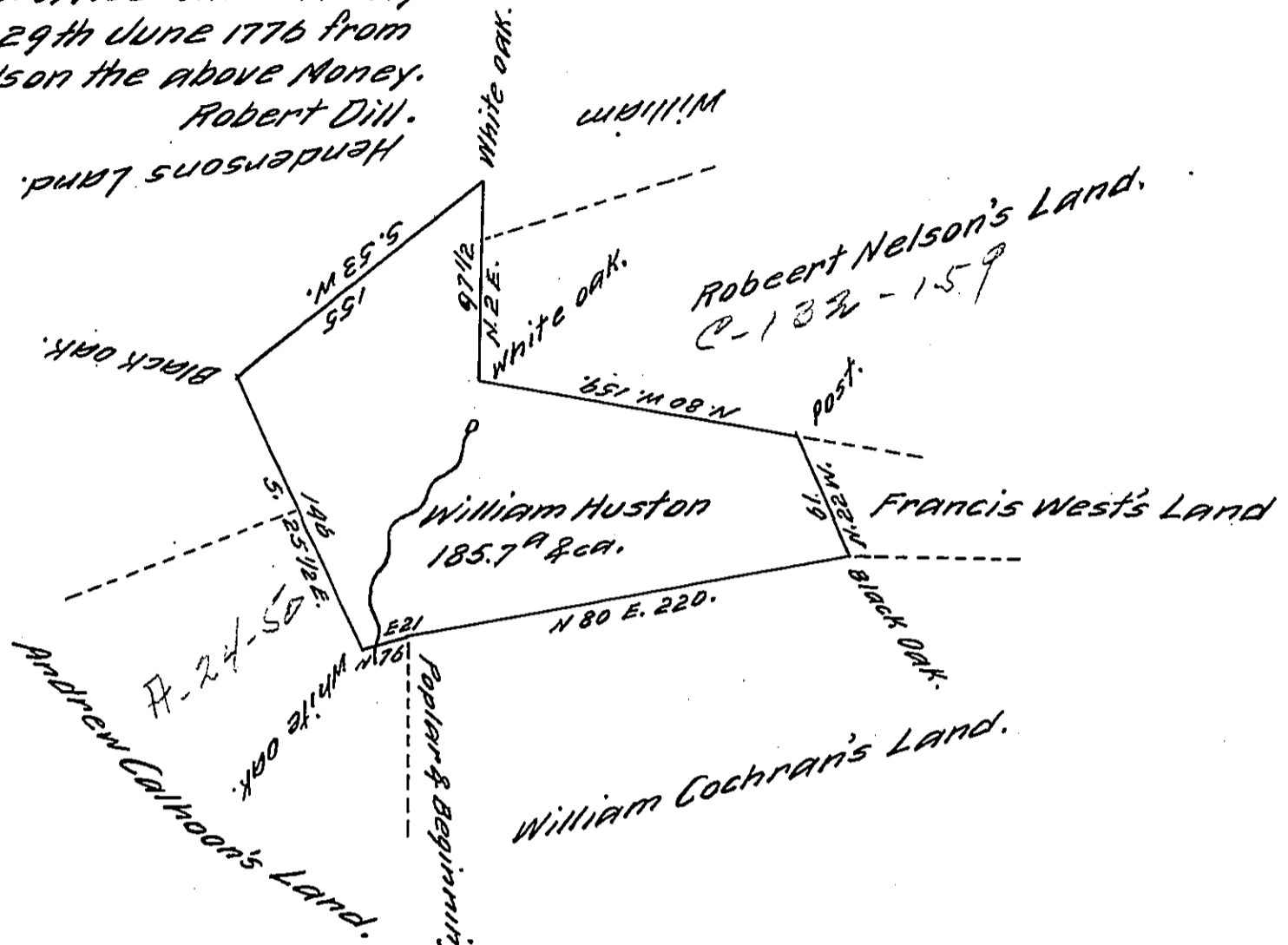

The Draught of a Tract of Land called — Situate  
in Fermanagh Township in Cumberland County Containing  
one Hundred and Eighty Five Acres and one Hundred  
and Eighteen perches with the usual Allowance of Six  
Acres p. Cent for Roads &ca. Resurveyed the 20th Day  
of February Anno Domini 1775 Agreeable to the Lines  
formerly Run by John Armstrong. In Pursuance of a  
warrant from the Honoble the Proprietaries to  
William Huston bearing Date at Philadelphia the 1st.  
Day of March Anno Domini 1755.
