



By warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 1742 surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 8<sup>mo</sup> 1743. to John Althouse ~~at 44 1/2~~ the above described Tract of 155<sup>03</sup> & allowance of Land.

By warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1747 surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of the same month to John Althouse the two small pieces of Land above described the one containing 13 <sup>as</sup> 3/4 & allowance and the other containing 47<sup>95</sup> & allowance.
