



A Draught of a tract of Land situate the greatest part in Springfield Township and the remainder in Haycock Township in the County of Bucks and Province of Pennsylvania: Containing One hundred and seventy one acres and 111 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six percent for Roads,

Being part of the Lottery Land on the branches of Tohickon that was now resurveyed for Nicholas Bock in pursuance of an order from the Surveyor General dated on the 19<sup>th</sup> January Anno 1768 directed to John Hart Deputy Surveyor. the same was formerly surveyed to John Sanders deceased now resurveyed by order of the said John Hart on the 6<sup>th</sup> March Anno 1769
