



A Draught of a tract of Land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the East side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River adjoining the Honorable the Proprietaries Manor on Wyaloosing Creek in the County of Northumberland containing Three hundred & fourteen acres & one hundred & twenty five perches besides the usual allowance of six pcent for Roads &<sup>te</sup>. Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1775 for Owen Biddle in pursuance of a warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774.
